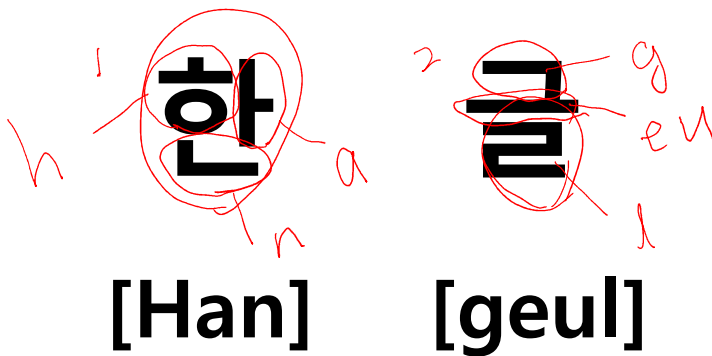


# Introduction of Korean Alphabet, Hangeul-1 (Historical background of Hangeul)



**Q : Who made  
*Hangeul* ?**

**A : King Se-jong**

***King Sejong***  
(1397 ~1450) was the  
fourth king of  
Joseon dynasty.



## *King Sejong* created '**훈민정음** (*Hun-min-jeong-eum*)

'*Hun-min-jeong-eum*'  
means 'Right words that teaches public'

1. The name for Korean alphabet.
2. The name for the book

It was created  
in 1443  
and announced  
in 1446.

Hangul was  
invented to enable  
ordinary people to  
express their ideas  
easily in writing.
